Guidelines

A shortlist of deserving applicants for the Scholarship will be drawn up immediately after the adjudication process in April by representatives of the Urdd's central sub-panel and the local panel. The short-listed applicants will then be invited to present an application letter indicating how the scholarship would be used to promote and develop their CDT work. The applications will then be considered by an established panel of judges and the applicants may be invited to attend an interview. It is hoped that the winner will be invited back the following year to present a selection of their work in the exhibition.

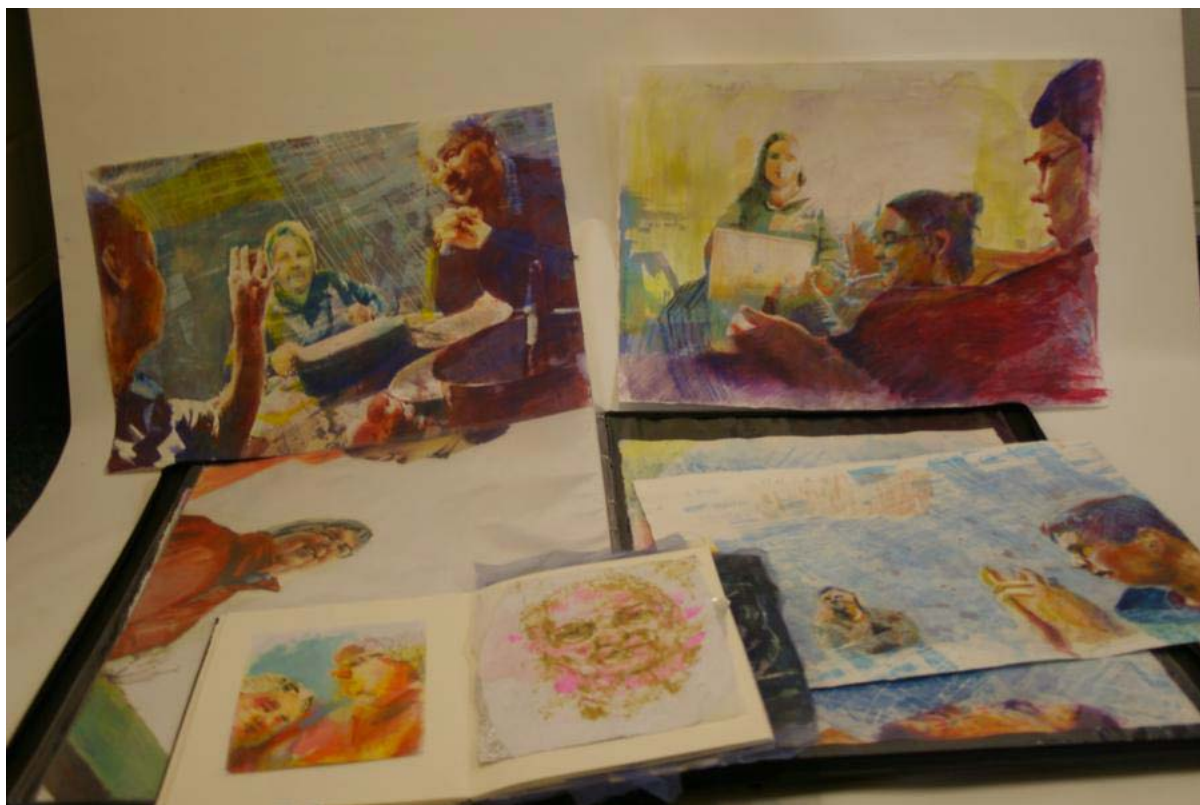
