Adroddiad y Trysorydd Rheon Tomos

Fe gynyddodd trosiant y mudiad i ychydig dros £7.5m yn ystod y flwyddyn a aeth heibio, hyn yn adlewyrchu twf o 3.3% ers 2007/08. Gwelwyd cynnydd pellach mewn incwm o'r canolfannau preswyl, hyn yn adlewyrchu eu pwysigrwydd i ni fel mudiad gan eu bod yn denu bron i hanner ein trosiant. Bu i Eisteddfod 2008 gyfarfod â chostau llwyfannu'r wyl gan adael gweddill bychan. Roedd yna hefyd dwf mewn cymynroddion a thanysgrifiadau eto'r llynedd ac mae'r gefnogaeth yma yn hynod werthfawr i ddatblygiad y mudiad. Llawer o ddiolch i bawb a gyfrannodd.

Mae'r Bwrdd Busnes yn gyfrifol am adolygu gwariant a chyllidebau'r mudiad mewn cydweithrediad â'r fîm rheoli. Ein nod ar ddechrau'r flwyddyn oedd gwneud gweddill o oddeutu £180,000 yn y flwyddyn, hyn er mwyn sicrhau arian wrth gefn i fuddsoddi mewn cynlluniau'r dyfodol. Dwi'n falch o fedru adrodd fod y targed (a mwy) wedi ei gyflawni, hyn drwy ymdrech lew a monitro cyson ar ran y swyddogion. Fel Cadeirydd y Bwrdd Busnes rwyf eisoedd wedi eu llonygarch ar ran pawb.

Er y newydd da yma, oherwydd bod gwerth ein buddsoddiadau wedi gostwng yn ystod y flwyddyn, hyn yn adlewyrchu perfformiad y marchnadoedd arian, fe fu gostyngiad o £58,000

yn lefel ein cronfeydd ers 31 Mawrth 2008. Mae'n amlwg fod hyn yn bryder i ni fel mudiad ond ymddengys fod y rhod wedi troi ychydig yn y chwe mis diwethaf oherwydd mae cynnydd o dros 20% bellach yn eu gwerth. Fe fyddwn yn cadw llygad barcud ar sefyllfa'r buddsoddiadau, ac yn wir effeithiau eraill yr hinsawdd economaidd anodd sydd ohoni, er mwyn ein galluogi i fedru sicrhau gwelliannau mewn sawl maes.

Fe welwyd gwariant cyfalaф o dros £400,000 llynedd, yn bennaf ar Ganolfan Ferlotu newydd yn Llangrannog ac adnewyddu Bloc y Berwyn yng Nglan-llyn. Mae'r Bwrdd Busnes hefyd wedi dechrau'r broses o osod cynlluniau adnewyddu a chynnal a chadw hir dymor ar gyfer ein hasedau. Fe fydd angen buddsoddi helaeth mewn sawl lle ond hyderwn y bydd gweledigaeth glir yn ein galluogi i gyflawni'r amcanion hyn.

Mae 2009/10 yn mynd i fod yn flwyddyn brysur arall yn enwedig gan i ni fod yn llwyddiannus yn denu incwm Ewropeaidd i ehangu ein gweithgarwch ar draws Cymru. Gyda seiliau ariannol cadarn yn eu lle gallwn wynebu'r her newydd yma gyda hyder.

Chief Executive's Report Efa Gruffudd Jones

It gives me great pleasure to present this report, which is a record of another exciting year.

The Urdd is an organisation full of vivacity and activity, where staff and volunteers work well together to ensure children and young people have unparalleled experiences.

Throughout our work our aim is to ensure that the Welsh language is a living and appealing language. We hope this has been achieved this year through our various activities.

One of the most important things we can do is improve confidence and skills in the Welsh language to ensure it is used naturally.

We do this through our magazines, our sporting activities, our residential centres, our eisteddfodau and our community work.

This year saw a new scheme established that will concentrate on improving young people's skills in situations outside the classroom. The *Llwybrau i'r Brig* (Routes to the Summit) scheme, partly funded by European Social Funds, has enabled us to employ 16 additional members of staff. We look forward to seeing the project's results over the coming years.

With our sporting activities and competitions continuing to increase in popularity, a separate Sport Department has been established. This will help ensure that Welsh is the language of play for children and young people.

It is a great honour for me to thank volunteers, supporters and staff of the Urdd for all their efforts and successes over the last year.

Treasurer's Report Rheon Tomos

The organisation's turnover increased to slightly over £7.5m during the last year, reflecting growth of 3.3% since 2007/08. A further increase was seen in the income from the residential centres, reflecting their importance to us as an organisation as they attract almost half our turnover. The 2008 Eisteddfod met the cost of staging the festival, leaving a small surplus. There was also an increase in bequests and subscriptions last year, and this support is very valuable to the development of the organisation.

The Business Board is responsible for reviewing the organisation's expenditure and budgets in co-operation with the management team. Our aim at the beginning of the year was to make a surplus of approximately £180,000 during the year, in order to ensure money in reserve to invest in schemes for the future. I am pleased to be able to report that the target was reached (and more) through concerted efforts and regular monitoring on the part of the officers. As Chairperson of the Business Board I have already congratulated the officers on behalf of the Board.

Despite this good news, due to the fall in the value of our investments during the year, reflecting the performance of the financial markets, the level of our funds have fallen by £58,000 since 31 March 2008. This is obviously a concern to us as an organisation, but it appears the wheel has turned slightly over the last six months resulting in an increase of 20% in their value. We will keep a close eye on the investments situation, and indeed the other effects of the current difficult economic climate, in order to enable us to secure improvements in a number of areas.

Last year saw capital expenditure of over £400,000, mainly on a new Equestrian Centre at Llangrannog and renovation of the Berwyn accommodation block at Glan-llyn. The Business Board has also commenced the process of setting down long-term renovation and maintenance plans for our assets. Extensive investment will be needed in a number of locations, but we are confident that a clear vision will enable us to achieve these objectives.

2009/10 is going to be another busy year as we have been successful in attracting European income to expand our activities across Wales. With robust financial foundations in place we can face this new challenge with confidence.





Gweithgareddau Hamdden, Addysgol a Chelfyddyol

Cafodd 49,950 o aelodau gyfle i ymuno mewn rhaglen o weithgareddau a chystadlaethau amrywiol.

Cafwyd cytundeb i weithio mewn partneriaeth ag Adran leuenctid y Cynulliad ar brosiect sy'n cael ei ran-ariannu gan Gronfa Gymdeithasol Ewrop, sef 'Llwybrau i'r Brig'. Mae 16 o staff newydd yn gweithio mewn 15 o awdurdodau lleol Cymru oddi fewn i ardaloedd Cydgyfeiriant. Byddant yn cynnig cyfleoedd ac achrediadau i aelodau 11-19 oed.

Ariannwyd Hwyl yr Haf, prosiect ar y cyd gyda Sain Ffagan: Amgueddfa Werin Cymru trwy gronfa waddol y Gemau Olympaidd. Cafodd dros 4,000 o aelodau cynradd y cyfle i ymuno mewn deuddydd o weithgareddau chwaraeon a chelfyddyol.

Uchafbwynt ein partneriaeth gyda Menter Patagonia eleni oedd taith 24 o aelodau i gynorthwyo gyda datblygu'r Gymraeg ymysg ieuencnid y Wladfa.

Mae'r Gronfa Loteri Fawr wedi ariannu prosiect fair blynnydd gwraith ieuencnid ym Merthyr lle bydd pobl ifanc 11-19 oed yn elwa o waith datblygu cyfleoedd a gweithgareddau yn yr ardal. Bu parhad hefyd yn ein partneriaeth gyda Chyngor Casnewydd i ariannu swydd ieuencnid. Braf nodi hefyd partneriaeth rhwng yr Urdd, Cyngor Wrecsam a'r Fenter leol i ariannu swyddog ieuencnid i weithio oddi fewn y sir.

Eleni gwelwyd Rimbojam yn esblygu o'r Jamboris sydd wedi bod yn graidd

i weithgareddau cynradd yr Urdd ers ugain mlynedd. Trwy bartneriaeth â Youth Music a Menter Môn lansiwyd y prosiect yn Venue Cymru, Llandudno, yng nghwmni dros 3,000 o aelodau cynradd yr Urdd yng ngogledd Cymru.

Am y tro cyntaf lluniwyd Neges Heddwch ac Ewyllys Da Urdd Gobaith Cymru ar y cyd rhwng adran dysgwyr ac adran iaith gyntaf - Ysgolion Plas Mawr a Fitzalan yng Nghaerdydd. Mae'r Neges, ar y thema Newid Hinsawdd, ar y we mewn 36 iaith, gan gynnwys ieithoedd lleiafrifol.

Mae dros 595 o bobl ifanc 14-19 oed wedi cofrestru gyda chynllun Gwirfoddolwyr y Mileniw. Mae'r cynllun yn gyfle gwynch i achredu'r gwaith arbennig mae pobl ifanc yn ei gyflawni yn wirfoddol ac mae 253 tystysgrif wedi eu cyflwyno eisoes.

Cafodd Eisteddfod Gynradd Rhanbarth Ceredigion ei gwe darlledu mewn partneriaeth rhwng yr Urdd a Phrifysgol Llambled o dan nawdd y cynllun *Widening Access*. Bu cyfle i 16 o bobl ifanc rhwng 16 a 18 oed gael hyfforddiant cyfryngol am ddiwrnod ym meysydd camera, sain, cynhyrchu, cyfarwyddo ac ati.

Mae'r teithiau tramor mor boblogaidd ag erioed gyda 1,680 wedi ymuno ar deithiau i Ffrainc, Awstria, Catalonia, Patagonia a Sweden.

Cynhaliwyd Cystadlaethau Rhanbarthol a Gwyliau Chwaraeon Cenedlaethol yng Nghaerdydd, Abertawe, Bangor, Aberystwyth a Llanelli, gyda thros 40,000 o aelodau'r Urdd yn cystadlu yn y cystadlaethau chwaraeon.

Daeth 150 o dimau i gystadlu yn yr wyl Rygbi Genedlaethol yn Llanelli, a daeth 1,800 o ferched ifanc mewn 140 o dimau i gystadlu yn y Gystadleuaeth Bêl-rwyd Genedlaethol yng Nghaerdydd.

Sefydlwyd Adran Chwaraeon annibynnol gyda strwythur newydd a swyddogion chwaraeon yn Eryri, Caerdydd, Rhondda Cynon Taf, Ceredigion a Phen-y-bont.

Cynhaliwyd cystadleuaeth griced newydd 50/50 yn llwyddiannus iawn - gyda'r rownd derfynol yn cael ei chynnal ar ddiwrnod cyntaf cyfres Y Lludw yng Nghaerdydd.

Derbyniodd dros 1,000 o staff a gwirfoddolwyr hyfforddiant chwaraeon.

Mae'r Adran Chwaraeon wedi cynnig hyfforddiant yn y canlynol - pêl-droed, rygbi, golff, pêl-rwyd, dawns, gymnasteg, tennis, hoci, arweinyddion chwaraeon 1,2,3, a thystysgrif Diwrnod Chwaraeon.

Llwyddodd fîm yr Urdd i ennill Cystadleuaeth Rygbi Saith Bob Ochr Dubai.

Bu'r Adran Chwaraeon yn cynnal sesiynau hyfforddi yng Ngŵyl Smithsonian Washington.

Leisure, Educational and Arts Activities

49,950 members were given the opportunity to take part in a variety of activities and competitions.

An agreement was reached to work in partnership with the Assembly's Youth Division on a project, partly funded by the European Social Fund, entitled *Llwybrau i'r Brig* (Routes to the Summit). 16 new members of staff will work in 15 local authorities in Wales within the Convergence areas. They will offer opportunities and accreditations to members aged 11-19 years of age.

A joint project with St Fagans: National History Museum was funded by the Olympic Games endowment fund. Over 4,000 members of primary school age took part in two days of Urdd activities, and enjoyed the usual attractions of St Fagans.

24 Urdd members travelled to Patagonia to develop the Welsh language among young people in the Welsh colony.

The Big Lottery Fund has funded a three year youth work project in Merthyr Tydfil where young people aged 11-19 benefit from development opportunities and activities in the area. There was also continuation of our partnership with Newport Council to fund a youth post. It is also worth noting the partnership between the Urdd, Wrexham Council and the local Menter Iaith to fund a youth officer to work within the county.

This year saw Rimbojam evolving from the Jamborees that have been central to the Urdd's primary school activities for

twenty years. By means of a partnership between Youth Music and Menter Môn, the project was launched at Venue Cymru, Llandudno, in the company of over 3,000 Urdd members from North Wales.

For the first time the Urdd Gobaith Cymru Peace and Goodwill Message was created jointly by first language and learners' Adrannau – Plas Mawr and Fitzalan Schools in Cardiff. The Message, on the theme of Climate Change, is on the internet in 36 languages, including minority languages.

Over 595 young people aged 14-19 have registered with The Millennium Volunteers scheme. The scheme is an excellent opportunity to accredit the exemplary work young people achieve voluntarily and 253 certificates have been presented.

The Ceredigion Regional Primary Eisteddfod was broadcast on the web in partnership between the Urdd and Lampeter University under the auspices of the *Widening Access* scheme. There was an opportunity for 16 young people between 16-18 years of age to gain media training for a day in the fields of camera work, audio, production, directing etc.

The visits abroad are as popular as ever with 1,680 having travelled to France, Austria, Catalonia, Patagonia and Sweden.

Sports

Regional competitions and National Sports Festivals were held in Cardiff, Swansea, Bangor, Aberystwyth and Llanelli, with over 40,000 Urdd members competing in the sports competitions.

150 teams competed in the National Rugby Festival in Llanelli and 1,800 girls in 140 teams competed in the National Netball Competition in Cardiff.

An independent Sports Department was established with a new structure and Sports Officers in Eryri, Cardiff, Rhondda Cynon Taf, Ceredigion and Bridgend.

A new 50/50 cricket competition was very successful – with the final round held on the first day of the Ashes series in Cardiff.

Over 1,000 staff and volunteers received sports training.

The Sports Department offered training in the following – football, rugby, golf, netball, dance, gymnastics, tennis, hockey, 1,2,3 sports leaders, and Sports Day certificate.

The Urdd team won the Dubai Seven a Side Rugby Competition.

The Sports Department held training sessions at the Smithsonian Festival in Washington USA.





Gwersyll yr Urdd Llangrannog

Over 20,000 stayed at the Centre.

The new Equestrian Centre was opened by Elin Jones, AM, Minister for Rural Affairs. The scheme was made possible by a grant of £134,000 from the Rural Development Scheme through Ceredigion County Council. This resource, like a number of others at the Centre is available for use by the local community and tourists.

The Centre won the Business of the Year award in the Ceredigion Business Awards, and also won a prize in the 'Environmental' category.

The turnover reached an all-time high at £2.2million. The Centre plays an increasingly important role with regards employment, the economy and quality of life of the local community. It is estimated that the Centre contributes £2.5million to the local economy and

employs almost a hundred members of staff. The Centre also has a policy of supporting local businesses.

The Investors in People standard was reached, once again.

The Centre's Catering Department won a number of awards including the *Curiad Calon Ceredigion* award. This award is given for attaining the criteria in Providing Healthy Food, High Standards in Customer Satisfaction and Excellence in Hygiene. The department also won the All Wales Healthy Options Gold Award, awarded for offering our customers a healthy menu. In addition, the department attained the Gold Standard in the Wales Food Hygiene Awards, awarded by the Wales Food Standards Agency.

Pentre Ifan is an ideal centre for small groups to enjoy a break in an idyllic part of Pembrokeshire.

Residential Centres

Gwersyll yr Urdd Glan-llyn

Over 12,000 stayed at the Centre.

It was another busy and successful year at Gwersyll Glan-llyn, with the income for the year reaching an all-time high, despite the economic recession.

Two new schemes were officially launched in July by Ieuan Wyn Jones AM, Deputy Prime Minister and Minister for the Economy and Transport in Wales. During the year, substantial work was completed to renovate and upgrade the Berwyn accommodation block. The work included creation of *en-suite* facilities in every room, a lounge for course leaders, a clothes drying room and installation of sun pipes to obtain natural lighting in the building. Also during the year, renovation of the Brenin Arthur boat was completed.

Many new contacts were established during the year, and a partnership with University College Bangor was

started, providing an Outdoor Pursuits module and working jointly on a Welsh A Level course. Glan-llyn also started working with Trinity College, Carmarthen on several aspects of the Residential Centre's work.

A series of other minor improvements were carried out to the Centre – on the Neuadd Ymgynull and the disco equipment, as well as improvements to Neuadd Wen, the sports room at the Centre.

A number of courses were held for the Activities Department staff enabling them to gain extra qualifications in canoeing, kayaking and minibus driving competency skills.

The number of daily visits increased, including teambuilding days for companies and organisations and activity taster days as part of the Gwynedd Children and Young People Support Fund Play Scheme.

Over 15,000 visited Gwersyll yr Urdd Caerdydd to take part in activities over the year, including almost 10,000 who stayed at the Centre.

Since opening four years ago, the number of people having stayed at the Centre has increased year on year.

The Centre is also the home of Ffwrnais Awen, a weekly performance club for a hundred young people, which is run jointly with Menter Iaith Caerdydd. Ffwrnais Awen performed at the Wales Millennium Centre's Weston Theatre three times during Eisteddfod week.

The Centre's Digital Club (for members between 14-18 years of age) meets weekly and produces podcasts and video programmes which can be sampled on the Centre's website. The Digital Club group was also busy during Eisteddfod week, creating a daily video that was broadcast on the web.




