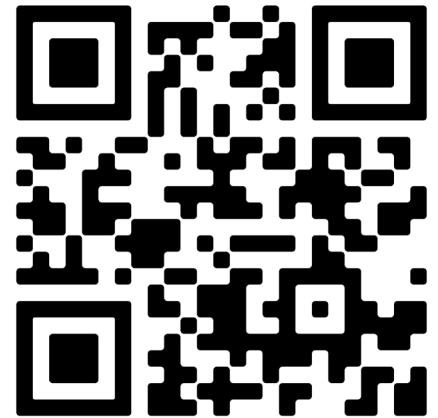

You can complete the worksheet with the children in the classroom.
