Taith - Moving the Goalsposts



Moving the Goalposts is a charity which is situated in Kilifi, Kenya and uses football as a tool to positively impact the lives of disadvantaged girls and young women between the ages of 9 – 25 in the rural coastal region of Kenya.

Dorcas Amakobe came to the Conference to speak with the audience about the work that they do in Kilifi, and the barriers that face the young women and girls in Kenya. By having Dorcas as part of the event it gave the attendees the opportunity to learn about the culture and how Moving the Goalposts are making a difference.

The Urdd continues to work with Moving the Goalposts with another trip planned for 2024, where staff, young ambassadors and apprentices will get the opportunity to visit the charity and see first hand the great work that they do.
