- On the 18th of May since 1922 the children and young people of Wales have reached out to the world with its annual **Peace and Goodwill Message from the young people of Wales.**
- It is unique to Wales.
- The welsh youth movement, Urdd Gobaith Cymru took responsibility for the Message in the 1950s.





- Wales is a country situated on the western side of the island of Britain.
- Wales is one of the four countries that make up the United Kingdom.
- It has a population of 3.1 million.
- The patron saint is 'St David'.
- The capital city is Cardiff, in the south east of the country.
- Wales a Celtic nation and is known for its rich culture and heritage such as singing, folklore and sports like rugby.

- •In Wales, it is estimated that 29.8% of the population speak Welsh. 44.74% of those under 25 years old speak Welsh.
- •It has official status in Wales and is the only official language of the United Kingdom other than English.
- •Welsh is known as a 'Celtic' language and shares roots with languages like Breton spoken in Brittany, western France.
- •Historians believe that Welsh has been spoken in the U.K since the Bronze Age.








- Wales' largest youth organisation
- It is a national voluntary youth organisation with over 55,000 members between the ages of 8-25 years old.
- Providing cultural, sporting and international opportunities through the medium of Welsh for children and young people
- Established in 1922 over 4 million people have benefited from being members of the Urdd.

- It is sent on the 18th of May every year.
- Sent for the first time in 1922 and every year since then without a break. That's almost 100 years.
- An opportunity for young people in Wales to express their opinion about things that are important to them and to connect with other young people worldwide.
